- ✓ Keen interest and willingness to commit to **four years of in-depth study** in Music

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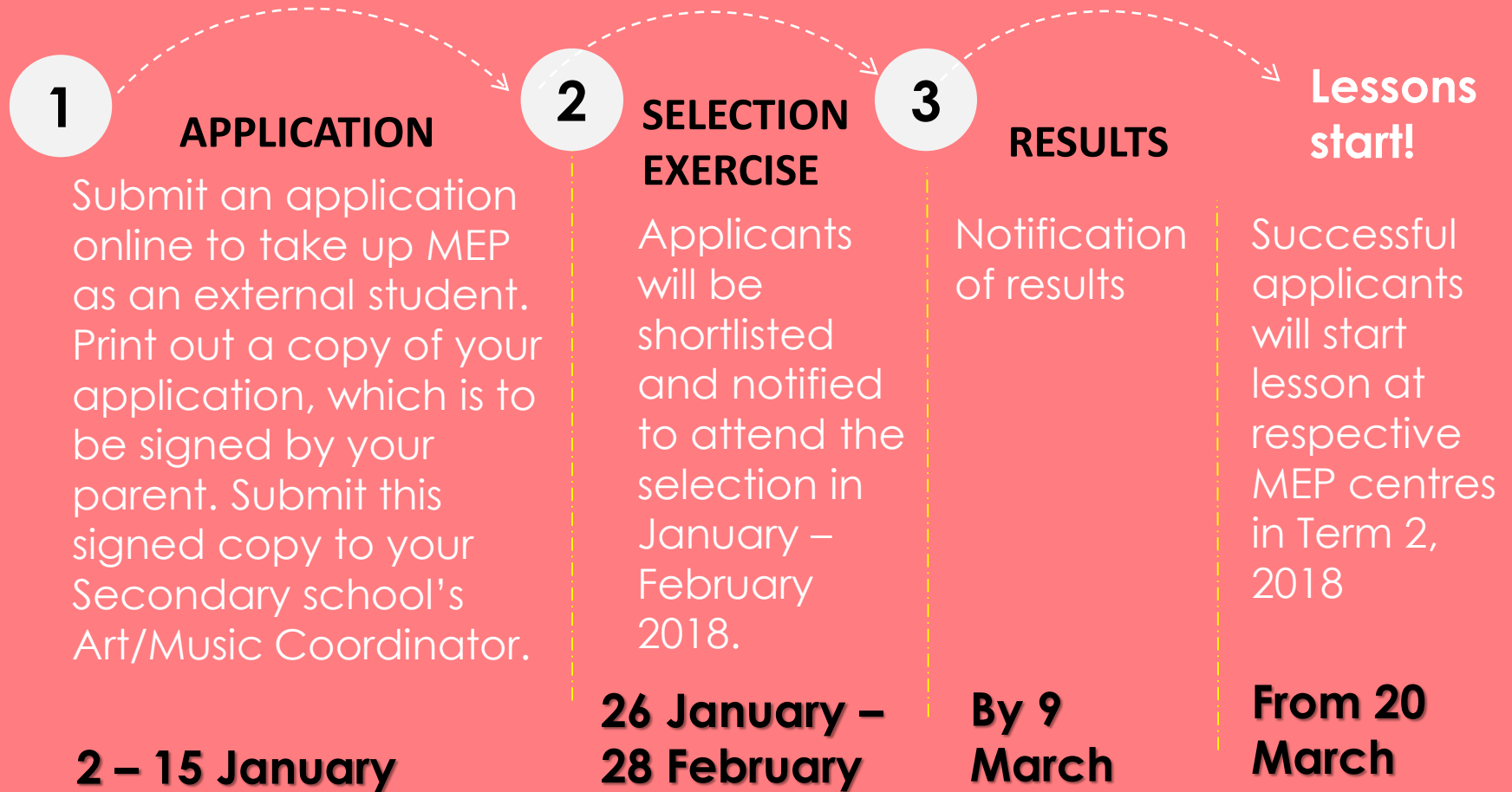
- ✓ Students have to sit for the MEP Selection Exercise if they are applying for the MEP Centres
