#### This briefing is for:

- A. Students interested and eligible for **Higher Mother Tongue**
- B. Students taking **Tamil Language**
- C. Students taking **Non-Tamil Indian Language** (**NTIL**), e.g. Bengali, Gujarati, Hindi, Punjabi, Urdu
- D. Students taking Foreign Languages (e.g. French, German, Japanese) or Asian
   Languages (e.g. Arabic, Burmese, Thai) in lieu of MT

#### A. Higher MT Language

- We are offering Higher Chinese and Higher Malay Languages for interested and eligible Sec 1 students
- Higher Tamil classes are conducted at the Umar Pulavar Tamil Language Centre

#### Why Higher Mother Tongue?

- For JC/CI admission
- Students who passed Higher Mother Tongue (HMT) at O levels will enjoy:
  - 2 bonus points in L1R5 aggregate computation
  - Able to use either HMT or English grade as L1 (better of the two)
- Note: HMT has no direct impact on Polytechnic / ITE admission


#### Why Higher Mother Tongue?

- More rigorous and in-depth curriculum
- Greater exposure to the Mother Tongue language and culture, to develop your child's passion and ability in the subject
- Will take GCE 'O' level MT exam at the end of Sec 3, and HMT exam at Sec 4

#### Eligibility for Higher Mother Tongue

- Higher MT will be offered to all Sec 1 students who met the criteria at PSLE (ie. Received MOE HMT offer letter) - \*Submit Reply Letter by today (latest 28 Dec)
- Students who do not have the MOE offer letter would need to appeal to school for Higher MT
- Students appealing for HMT should score at least Merit in PSLE Higher MT, or A\* in PSLE MT
- Students who did not meet the requirements but still wish to take Higher MT are to see HOD/MTL. A diagnostic test may be conducted for selected students in Term 1, Week 1, 2017.

#### Higher Mother Tongue Diagnostic Test

- Higher Chinese Diagnostic Test
- Date: Week 2, 8 Jan 2018 (Mon)
- Time & Venue to be announced
- Higher Malay Diagnostic Test will be conducted for all ML Express and NA students by Week 2.

#### Mother Tongue books

- If you are planning to take Higher MT, do not buy your MT books first.
- If you have bought them, keep the receipt and <u>do not</u> write your names on the books, so that you can exchange at the bookshop if you are offered a different MT subject

#### B. Tamil Language

 TL Centre is at Sembawang Secondary School

 TL students to register at Sembawang Secondary School on Tuesday, 2 January 2018 between 2.30 pm and 5.30 pm (To be confirmed through morning announcement)

#### Tamil Language at Sembawang Sec

- Tamil classes for students in the Express and Normal Academic courses are conducted once a week every Monday, 3 - 6pm (approximately 3 hrs per day).
- Basic Tamil (Normal Technical course) lesson is 3 periods per week. Classes (approximately 1.5 hrs) are conducted once a week on every Wednesday, 3.00 - 4.30pm.

#### C. NTIL

- Non-Tamil Indian students taking Bengali,
   Gujarati, Hindi, Punjabi and Urdu are required to inform their Class Mentors the following matters;
- a. Non-Tamil Indian Language they are taking;
- b. Centre that they attend lessons in 2018
- c. Days/ Time of their lessons

on the first day of school i.e. 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2018.

#### Commencement of lessons

- Announcements will be made on commencement of lessons(HMT/Tamil/Foreign Languages) during Week 1 of school.
- Announcements on exams dates will also be announced accordingly.
- Students are strongly encouraged to check updates pertaining to their classes/examinations matters at the Mother Tongue notice board outside HOD room regularly.

- Does not include 3<sup>rd</sup> language
- Upon approval, your child will need to apply for a place at the MOE Language Centre (Bishan or Newton). Availability of places is on a first-come-firstserved basis.

## D. Foreign Languages / Asian Languages in lieu of MT

- \*Pls note that it is our school policy that your child/ward takes the year-end exam for French/German/Japanese, whether he/she has secured a place in the MOELC, or opted for private study
- \*The marks are computed in the overall percentage and may affect your child/ward's promotion, so it is important to ensure he/she put in effort for the subject
